Minutes of February 18, 2026 – MacKenzie Bonaiuto moved to approve the minutes of February 18, 2026, Linda McKinney seconded. Unanimous.

Speaker – No speaker for the month of March.

Financial Report/Strategy for Grants – Current balance is \$31,834.93. No funding requests were submitted.

Local Access Issues –

BJ's has reached full compliance. This matter is closed. Regarding the north street parking lot, the work that was scheduled to be done at the accessible parking spaces located at Alberto's has been completed. Puritan's accessible parking spaces are pending improvements. Paul Logan was informed that the work will be taking place this spring.

The BDC had a brief discussion on accessible parking spaces and the impact of snow. It was suggested to invite the Hyannis Business Improvement District to discuss. It was also suggested to invite Chief Challies to discuss her role as the Emergency Response Coordinator for Barnstable. Eileen Elias and Paul Logan will be discussing how to coordinate getting information to faith-based organizations.

Report from the Posters Subcommittee – John Lundborn reported that he is working on a poster relating to illegal parking in fire lanes. A draft will be available next month.

Report from the Scholarships Subcommittee – Linda McKinney stated that it is still early to provide a report. She will not receive scholarship recipient information until May or June.

BDC Awareness Publicity (Events/Fairs/Shows) -

Eileen Elias mentioned an event happening on April 14, 2026, addressing domestic abuse. The event is being held at the Universal Church in Barnstable.

Revising do's and don'ts flyer – No update.

Mass. AAB Variance Request Subcommittee/DPW Sub Committee – A complaint was filed with the AAB for several violations at 51 Main Street Hyannis, MA 02601.

Old Irish Village in Hyannis has been purchased by the Riverview School. Riverview School had initially requested a variance to the elevator requirement; however, their request has since been withdrawn.

ADA Self – Evaluation and Transition Plan update – A brief discussion was held on Mill Way beach and a citizens request to relocate the accessible parking spots closer to beach access. Tammy Cunningham and John Lundborn will visit the site and provide an update at the next disability commission meeting.

TOB Beach Sticker accessibility – This matter has been resolved.
