PUBLIC HEARINGS

1. New Annual §12 Wine & Malt License

In accordance with MGL c.138 and MGL c.140, an application has been filed by The Buttercup Café LLC dba **The Buttercup Cafe**, 3226 Main St/Rt 6A, Barnstable, to add a new annual wine and malt license to this existing common victualler license. Establishment is currently licensed for 49 seats inside, and 16 seats outside. Proposed alcohol manager is Melissa Jankowski; hours of wine and malt service will be daily from 11am to 7pm (daily operating hours are 7am-7pm).

2. New Annual Common Victualler License

In accordance with MGL c.140, an application has been filed by Isabella's Pizzeria Inc. dba **Isabella's Pizzeria**, 640 Main Street, Hyannis, for a new annual common victualler license with Ana Pinto as the manager. Proposal includes seating for 115 patrons, with daily hours of operation from Tuesday – Sunday 7am-12pm, then 5pm to 10pm; closed on Monday.

In an emergency, a public body shall post notice as soon as reasonably possible prior to such meeting. Notice shall be printed in a legible, easily understandable format and shall contain: the date, time and place of such meeting and a listing of topics that the chair reasonably anticipates will be discussed at the meeting. Meetings of a local public body, notice shall be filed with the municipal clerk, and posted in a manner conspicuously visible to the public at all hours
